

"LE-GO" of the Electronics and Grab a Book!

We are excited to promote two reading challenges for the students at BPES during **January reading month!** Students will work toward **extra recess** for their class, as well as a **school-wide** reading incentive!

Our school goal is to read a total of **350,000 minutes** between Monday January 3rd and Friday January 31! This can include a family member **reading to the student** or time spent **listening to audio books**. Mrs. Bialeski and Mr. West have set this challenging goal for students and have a school-wide **silly surprise** in store for the entire school on January 31 if we reach the goal!

Here's how it works:

- On the back of this paper, students will track their individual reading progress.
- For each **ten minutes** they read, they will color in a lego brick.
- After they complete each **column of bricks** (100 minutes read), they will **tear off** the '**100 minute brick**' at the bottom of the page.
- Write their name on the '100 minute brick' and have a parent initial.
- They will put the ticket in the "**lego brick box**" in their team area. (Have them ask their teacher if they can't locate the box.)
- We will collect the '100 minute bricks' from each team's box **every week** and track each grade's reading progress in the **front hallway cabinet**.
- Students will be able to see their grade level's reading progress and how close we are as a school to reaching our goal of **350,000 minutes** of reading!
- Once individual students complete **all 50 bricks** on the paper or **500 total minutes** of reading, they can turn their entire paper into their teacher to count toward their class's extra recess.

We hope each student participates in this new and exciting reading incentive to help celebrate January Reading Month! If each student does their part and reads 500 minutes, we will be sure to meet our school-wide goal of 350,000 minutes of reading!
